Outdoor Adventure Leader

Term of employment: June 1st – August 17th

Description:

The Outdoor Adventure Leader will report to the Outdoor Adventure Supervisor. As an Outdoor Adventure Leader you will be responsible for the ongoing delivery of the Outdoor Adventure Camp and connecting children to nature on a daily basis. You will also work in coordination with the other Outdoor Adventure Leaders, the Outdoor Adventure Supervisor and the Active Living Coordinator to establish the program structure, goals and objectives. This program is open to children and youth 4-12 years of age. The program will take place 4 days a week in the morning and afternoon however you may be required to work evenings and weekends depending on events. The program will be focused around connecting children to nature and encouraging children to explore, take risks and be active outside in a safe environment. This position is based on a 40 hour work week.

In addition a full summer soccer program is offered over the course of the summer as well as additional programs for youth. You will be required to coach and assist in the promotion and operation of all summer programs.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the supervision and safety of all participants in our programs
- Ensure all programs have a safe and child centered delivery and approach
- Responsible for the creation and delivery of all promotional materials
- Work in coordination with the Sport Coordinator towards the development and implementation of the Summer Soccer Program. This includes scheduling, field maintenance and team organization
- Work with the Outdoor Adventure Supervisor, Summer Sport Coordinator and Active Living Coordinator to develop and create age appropriate nature focused activities that are inclusive, supportive and encourage risk taking
- Ongoing communication between parents, Dr. Carson & Marion Murray Community Centre staff, co workers, and key stakeholders
- Assist the Events Coordinator in the planning and delivery of community special events which include but are not limited to: Canada Day Ceremonies, Old Home Week Festival etc

Requirements:

- Up to date Criminal Record Check upon interview is an asset
- Child Abuse Registry must be complete prior to start date
- Current Emergency First Aid and CPR is an asset
